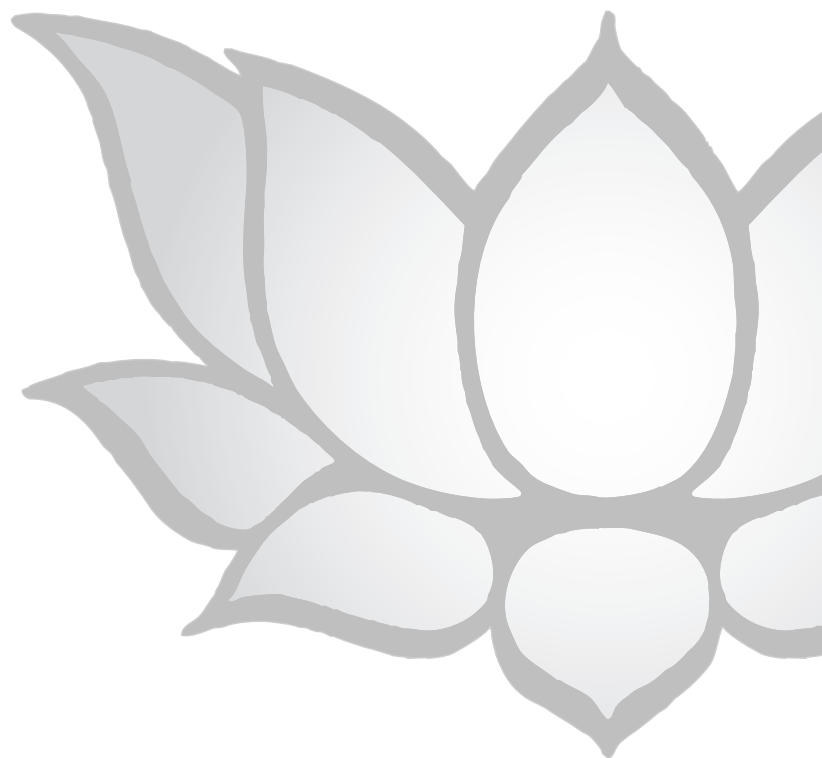

# Welcome


